An aerial map is a map which is from a phot taken from above (by a satellite).

Nuneaton is a Town.

Physical geography is a geographical feature that naturally occurs. (Made by nature).

Human geography is a geographical feature that is manmade. (Made by humans).

Environments can change in many ways from flooding, drought and fire to new buildings, demolishing buildings or by adding new roads.

Every map needs a key so that you know what the symbols mean.

A farm, canal, buildings and roads all count as human features of geography.



Factories need a site that is flat, easily accessed by roads and away.

Attleborough has changed over the years with new schools, shops and roads.

Glenridding is a village in the Lake district that was changed when it flooded.

Key Vocabulary

- **Town**—a built-up area that is larger than a village and generally smaller than a city.
- **Site**—an area of ground where a place is to be built.
- **Village**—a built up area smaller than a town where people live.
