When applying mod-roc to a mask, we should cut it into strips, dip it in water, cover the mask and smooth it out.

The white material we use to make the masks is called mod-roc.

Greeks wore masks to show clearly the characters' expressions and emotions.

Ancient Greek masks are used today as symbols of drama.

Greeks performed plays in an amphitheatre.

To add detail to our masks, we will use paint.

A mask is a covering for all or part of the face.

Mod-roc cannot be moulded into different shapes once it is dry.

Greek masks had large mouth holes so the actors could project their voices to the back of the theatre and sing clearly.

We can add a 3D effect to our masks with newspaper and masking tape.
