A computer network is how computers communicate with each other.

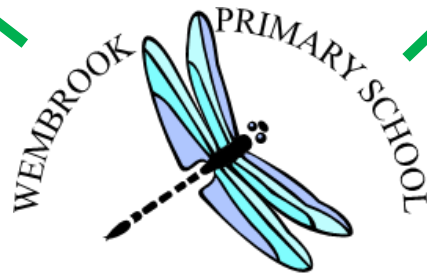
Netiquette is how we behave online.
