When did you last support your child with their homework?

A reminder:

Some activities may take over an hour or more to complete, most will take considerable less. Your child will be able to choose which homework they do, so they should be able to complete work that they find easier to engage with.

In brief, the expectation is that your child will only have one homework to complete during most weeks. **With the number of homework tasks being greatly reduced, we sincerely hope that all children will complete their homework when expected.**

We also hope that the work will be done to a good standard, equal to the work that they do in school.

Nursery Places 2025/26

Places for September 2025 are almost full

Our very popular nursery, which has an excellent reputation, is finalising applications for September.

We provide 15 hours care in either morning or afternoon sessions.

We are also able to offer 30 hour free provision for parents who are eligible for this funding.

In brief, the free full-time provision is for working parents who both earn more than approximately £180 a week.

For single parents it is just the one parent who needs to be earning.
