Parents Questionnaire 2024

In November 2024, all parents and carers were invited to fill in a questionnaire about the school. This was not only to gauge how you feel the school is doing but also to allow us to contemplate on whether there is anything we can do differently or better.

Overall the findings were very complimentary. We were astounded that we received 533 replies, which in its self we believe says a lot about how you perceive the school.

As you would expect numerous points were raised which as a school we will be reflecting on over the next few months. We did however take comfort that the vast majority of points raised in the 2022 questionnaire were not repeated again, as hopefully these issues have been addressed.

- Communication. Overall a very positive response, it was one of the areas a few parents referenced in 2022. The general consensus was that parents liked the new emails although a few did lament the stopping of the link books.
- Extra Curricular Clubs. With 40 clubs run last year we strongly believe that we offer a service second to none. However, a few parents recorded their disappointment that their child did not always get a place on a club. All staff generously give up their own time which the school is very grateful for. This perhaps is a reminder that if your child is fortunate enough to be allocated a place, please make sure they attend every week.
- Different cultures and celebrating diversity. One parent wrote “ the best thing about Wembrook is that it is a diverse school which embraces all cultural and religious practices. The school shows they are promoting equality and diversity” A small number of parents disagreed and felt that we should do more. We will reflect on all these observations.
- Along with a few practical suggestions, such as a wider path, the above were the only repeated comments that suggested that the school should be working on.
