## Letter from the Governors

As we begin to approach the end of yet another busy term, I thought it might be appropriate to let you know about some of the key areas the governors have been working on during this academic year.



The schools finance has been one focus this year. As always, we are very proud how the school allocates its funding. We know we are fortunate that with being a large school we are able to be generous in how we spend the money. Whether it be a major refurbishment of the school library, purchasing new learning resources or subsidising school trips. However, you will be aware that many school budgets are in serious difficulties. This is not the case at Wembrook but the Governors Resource Sub-committee has had to work very hard and make some difficult decisions to ensure that the school continues to give all our pupils a first class education.

The governors, along with staff have spent a lot of time looking at our most recent school development plan. The WEMPIP looks at a number of developments that aim to further improve the school. Staff and leaders are clearly working very hard and we are optimistic that the initiatives will be successful.

The governors have also looked at the statutory data that was compiled from the external tests that took place last summer.
