

# Science - Plants

Deciduous trees lose their leaves annually. Evergreen trees retain their needles or leaves all – year round.

Daffodils grow in the spring.

Acorns are a seed from an oak tree.

Plants can grow in places such as soil, water, sand and rocks.

A baby plant is called a seedling.

When a plant sprouts, it grows shoots.

Germination is when conditions are right for growth and seeds soak up water, swell and burst from their shell.

Conkers are the common name for a seed on horse chestnut trees.

A fully grown tree is called a mature tree.

Plants that grow naturally in their environments without help from people are called wild plants.
