The role of the stem is to transport water around the plant.

The felos is not part of a flower.

The role of a filament is to hold up the anther.

Germination is when a seed starts to grow.

The stages of the lifecycle of a plant include: Germination, pollination, Fertilisation, Seed dispersal.



The role of an anther is to produce pollen.

Holding is not a method of seed dispersal.

The stages of pollination include: The flowers bright colour and fragrance attract the insect. Step 2 The insect arrives at the flower to collect nectar.

The carpel includes the female part of a plant.

Water, light and carbon dioxide are needed for photosynthesis.
