A very happy New Year. I hope you all had a wonderful relaxing and peaceful break and are ready for 2025.....is it really 25 years since the Millennium????



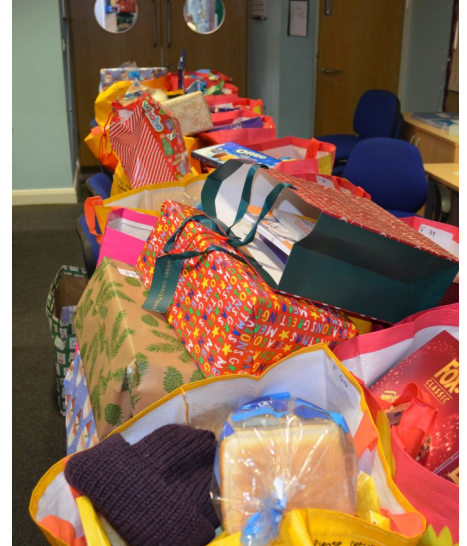
Thank you
