A self-portrait is a piece of art based on yourself.


Marcus Gheeraerts is famous for painting Elizabeth I.

Cross hatching creates shading effects when lines are drawn at an angle to each other.

A sketch book is used to record, experiment and practise my colour mixing.

Pencil can be used to add shade to create darker areas in a sketch.

Colours can create moods and emotions.



Key Vocabulary

- **Realistic** - A true representation of a person, place or object. Looks just like the real thing.
- **Sketching** - Using a sharp pencil to draw lightly.
- **Shading** - Shows where areas of darkness and light are.
- **Blending** - This is when colours are mixed together to make a new substance / colour.
- **Mood** - The feeling expressed in the painting. How does it make you feel?

A sketch book can be used to practise drawing something for the first time.

Proportion refers to drawing the size of features as accurately as possible.

Iconography is the use of symbols in a portrait.
