During Easter, Christians remember Jesus' death and resurrection.


In the Christian story Salvation means being saved or rescued from trouble.

Key Vocabulary

- ⇒ **Incarnation** - when something very special comes to life in a new way, like when a person or an idea becomes real and can be seen and touched.
- ⇒ **Salvation** - being saved or helped when you're in trouble, like when someone rescues you or keeps you safe.
- ⇒ **Disciples** - people who follow and learn from a teacher they really trust.
- ⇒ **Followers** - people who listen to Jesus and try to live the way He teaches, like being kind, loving, and helping others.
- ⇒ **Resurrection** - coming back to life after being dead.
