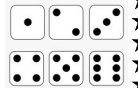
Number

Numbers to learn:

1 2 3 4 5 . These numbers will be taught using our Numberblocks and NCETM scheme.

Children will work on counting using 1-1 correspondence and will focus on matching amounts to numerals.

They will be taught to subitise (quick instant recall of number patterns). A dice will be used to get the children to instantly recognise the patterns.



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Children will focus on social skills including:

Name writing Assessments.
