The steady beat in a piece of music is called the pulse.



This musical note represents 2 beats.

The pattern of sounds in music is called the rhythm.

A duet is a piece of music with 2 parts.



This is the musical note C.



This is a glockenspiel.



This is the musical note E.



This symbol means to rest (make no sound on an instrument).



This bar has 4 beats.



This musical note is called a crotchet.

Key Vocabulary

- **Bar** - divides a piece of music into small sections each with the same number of beats.
- **Duet** - a piece of music played in two parts.
- **Pulse** - the steady beat which sets the tempo of the music.
- **Rhythm** - a pattern of sounds repeated to a regular pulse.
- **Tempo** - the speed of the music.
