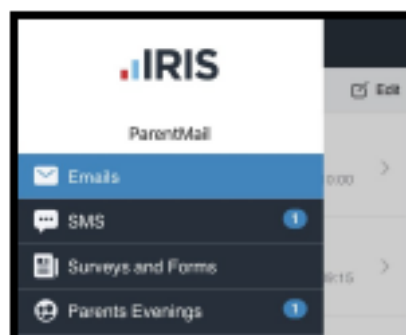
Appointments can be made from today and will close 3 days before Parents' Evening. Should you wish to make any changes after this date please contact the school office.

Appointments can now be booked through Parentmail.

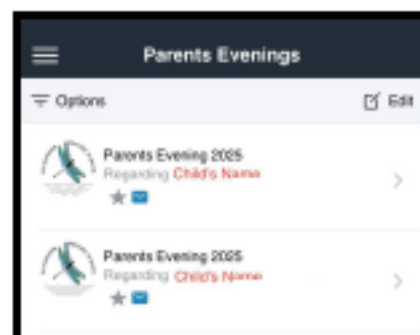

1. Open **Parent Mail App**

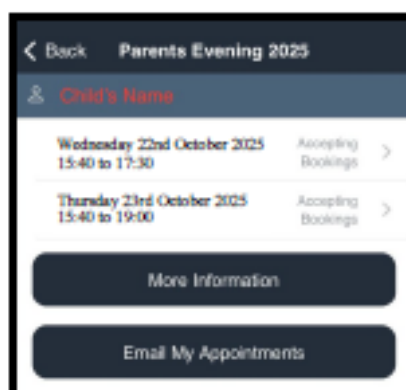


2. Click **Parents Evenings**

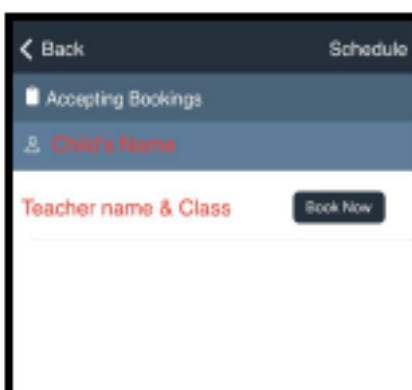


3. Click '**Parents Evening**' for your child

4. Click preferred '**date**' of Parents Evening

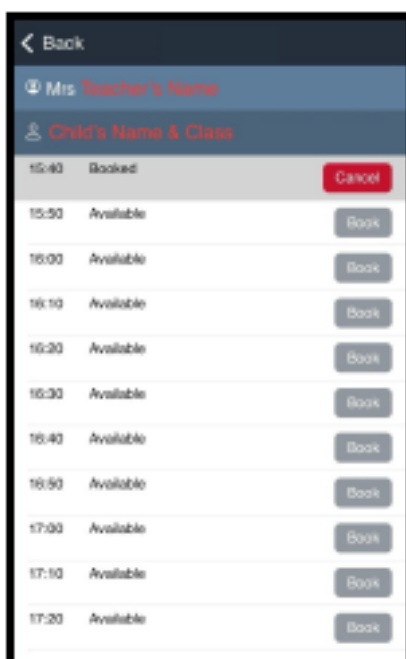


5. Click on '**Book Now**' next to Teacher name & Class



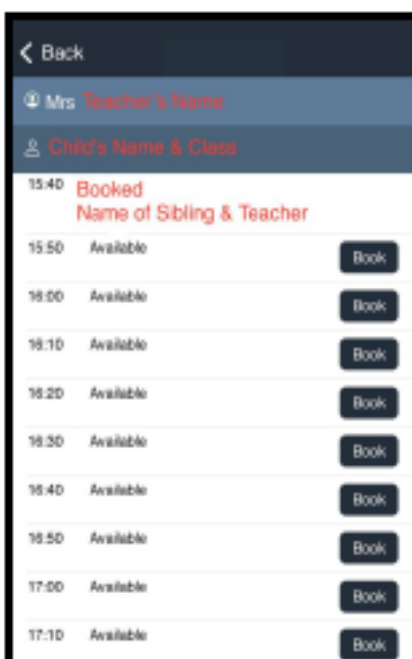
6. Click '**Book**' for selected available time
