The main features of a plant are: stem, roots, leaves and flower.

Deciduous trees shed their leaves each year.

Evergreen trees keep their leaves all year round.

The main features of a tree are roots, trunk, branches and leaves.



Plants use the stem to hold them upright and to carry water and nutrients around the plant.

Plants use their roots to take up water from the soil.

Key Vocabulary

- **Deciduous** - a type of plant that loses its leaves in Autumn each year.
- **Evergreen** - a type of plant that keeps its leaves all year round, even in Winter.
- **Stem** - the part of the plant which grows above the ground to support it.
- **Nutrients** - something found in soil that helps plants to grow.
