A story board is used to plan the story of the film before filming begins.

Photos are taken and used to create the film.

Professional animators usually take 24 frames to create 1 second of film.

Wallace and Gromit is a famous stop frame animation movie.

One still image or photo is called a 'frame'.

Images are shown quickly.

Stop frame animation involves drawings or models.

Sound is usually added to the photos after filming.

It is only used to create some films.

Animators can use drawings, clay, toys, puppets, paper or people.
