On a topographical map the colours show the height of land above sea level.

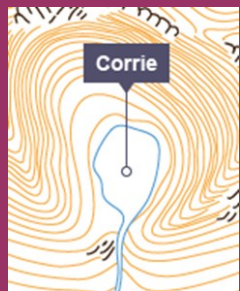
The Baltic sea is enclosed by Denmark, Finland, Sweden as well as other European Countries.
