You are probably aware that the Pingles Sports Centre has had a lot of building work done over the last 12 months. This cutting edge project, costing over £4.2 million is to allow and model how large civic buildings can be net zero. This is not only important now but even more for the future of our planet.

Working alongside Nuneaton and Bedworth brough council and the architect, Nic Purton, a small group of Wembrook pupils have been finding all about this fascinating project.

The pupils learnt about how the solar panels are collecting energy that is then being used to both heat and cool the leisure centre.

The energy from the solar panels are also being used to power the ground pumps, with the energy they create heating the swimming pool.

The science and the engineering is incredibly complicated but the drive to be Net Zero highlights the forward thinking attitude all borough councils and public buildings need to adopt.
