**Wicksteed: Day Tripper/We can work it out**

Many thanks for all the returned forms and money for our grand day out to Wicksteed Park. We are still waiting on a small number of pupils to return their forms and money. Please ensure that these are returned as soon as possible, **otherwise we will assume that your child is not going.**

Below is a long list of details about the trip. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to speak to your child's teacher before Thursday.

- Many thanks for all the kind offers to help with the trip. Those parents who are helping will have been contacted. If you have not been asked, we are sorry but we were unable to accommodate everyone.
1. The coaches will be leaving promptly at 9:00am. **All children need to be in school by 8:40am to register.**
  2. Children must wear a school top, however, they are allowed to wear their own trousers/shorts and training shoes for the day.
  3. We are anticipating all types of weather! All children should come to school with a waterproof coat. If the forecast is good, you may wish to put sun cream on your child before they come to school and make sure they are wearing a hat.
  4. If your child suffers from travel sickness and you normally give them a tablet, please give them one before they come to school. We will not be administering any tablets in school. If your child is likely to feel unwell, please let the class teacher know so that we can keep an eye on them.
  5. It would be very helpful if you send your child's packed lunch in a plastic bag, which can be disposed of at the end of their meal. **A plastic carrier bag is ideal,** with the pupil's name clearly written on the outside.
  6. Drinks should be non fizzy. If it is especially warm, you may wish to pack more than one. Drinks should be disposable and not glass.
  7. The children will be exploring the park in small groups under the direct supervision of an adult and their class teacher. Please talk to them about how you expect them to behave throughout the day.



8. There is no need for the children to take any money. However, if you would like them to have a small Amount so they can buy an Ice cream, please ensure it is in an envelope with their name clearly written on it.

9. Children should not take anything electrical, including cameras, games or mobile phones.

10. **VERY IMPORTANT** We anticipate that we will arrive back at school at approximately 5:00pm to 5:15pm. All pupils will be dismissed from their

classroom. **You will not be allowed to collect them from the coach.** Please be patient in allowing them to return to their class before they are dismissed.

11. **Please let your class teacher know if you wish your child to walk home on their own or you want them to go to a siblings classroom. A brief email will be sufficient.**
