Safeguarding and Child Protection

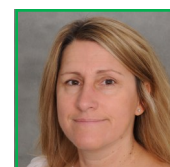

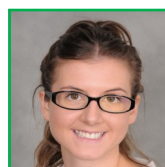

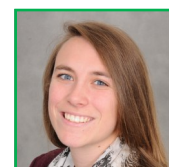
