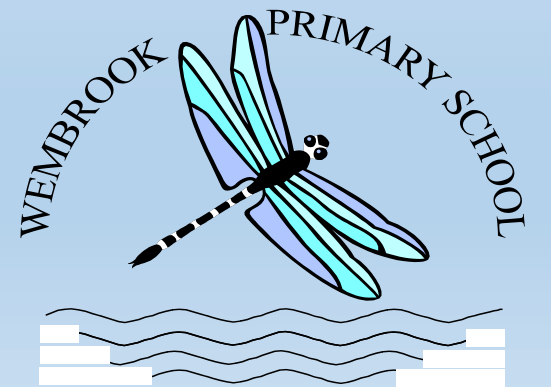


Welcoming Wembrook children back to school.

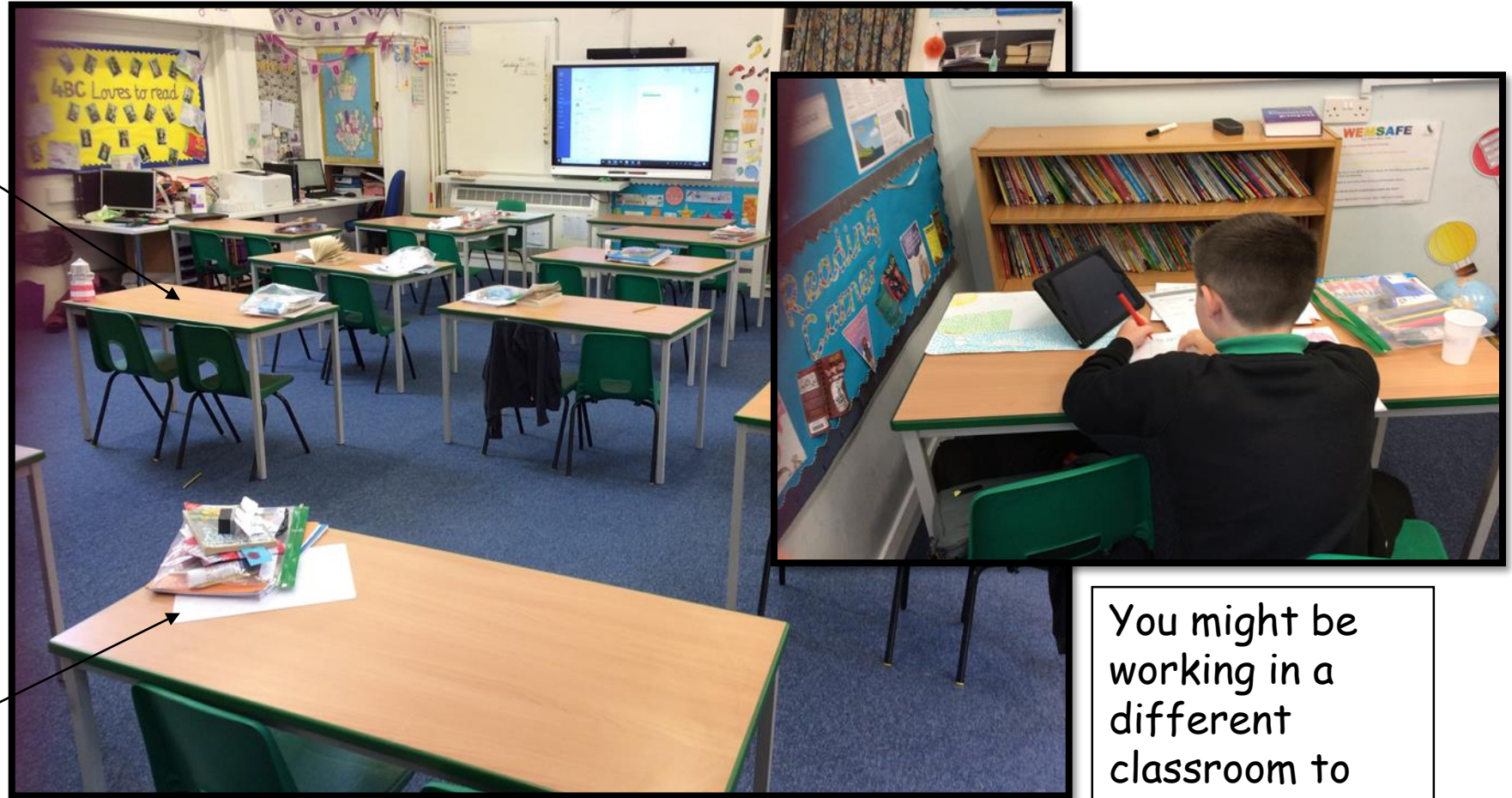


What do the classrooms look like?
