## Factors that the school has considered

- School attendance will be compulsory, all children unless they are medically shielding must attend.
- Schools are to operate a twin strategy of limiting contact between pupils and implementing hygiene measures.
- Primary pupils can work in class sizes of 30 pupils.
- Where circumstances dictate, schools can look to implement year group bubbles.
- The DFE recognises that younger children will not be able to maintain social distancing and it is acceptable for them not to distance within their group.
- Pupils should remove face coverings when they are in school.
- Outside agency staff, such as peripatetic music teachers, are able to attend schools.
- Kids Club will reopen
- All the good practices that we introduced over the summer term, such as additional cleaning and zoning play on the playground, will continue.
- Staggered starts and finishes to the school day, to reduce the number of parents in school at any one time.

We have tried to stagger the day, with an awareness that with many parents working they will need to be able to drop their children off at an appropriate time so that they can attend work as soon as possible.


## Introducing Deli Bags

With our kitchen staff we have tried to reduce the number of pupils having lunch in the hall. So we will be introducing hot deli bags which can be eaten in the classroom. Pupils will alternate between normal hot meals one week and then deli bags the following week. This is for all pupils from Year One to Year Six. Several schools were using them last term and they come highly recommended. Please see additional PDF's attached.
To put it simply, if your pupil is down for a deli bag week they will not be able to have any of the other hot meal options, although of course they can bring sandwiches. Likewise if they are down for hot dinners that week they will not be able to have a deli bag........ I hope that makes sense!
Deli bags will be charged at a normal hot meal rate of $£ 2.25$.
Reception will be hot dinners all term.
