# Mid Day Supervisor

# **Covid 19 Protocol for Suspected Cases**

This protocol will be updated if government guidelines change.

### Your Child has got Coronavirus Symptoms

- 1. They do not come to school. If they are in school you will need to collect them immediately.
- 2. Book a test. Inform the school that the test has been booked.

#### The test is negative

- 3. Inform the school of the result. An email would be preferred. (admin2629@welearn365.com)
- 4. The child can return to school if 48 hours has elapsed since the symptoms have developed and they and everyone in the household are well.
- 5. If the child is still unwell or other members are showing symptoms then another test will need to take place.

### The test is positive

- 6. Inform the school of the result. An email would be preferred. (admin2629@welearn365.com)
- 7. The child needs to isolate for a minimum of 10 days and only when they have no temperature will they be able to return.
- 8. Other children and adults who have had direct contact with the child are sent home and have to isolate for 14 days. They can then return as long as they have no symptoms. If they develop symptoms they must be tested.
- 9. You will need to alert NHS Test and Trace.

# Someone in your home has got Coronavirus Symptoms

- 10. Book a test. Inform the school that the test has been booked
- 11. Pupils will have to stay off until their test is returned negative.

# Someone in your home has tested positive

12. The whole household should isolate for 14 days. If anyone develops symptoms they should be tested.
