We expect all adult visitors to the school site to be wearing a mask.

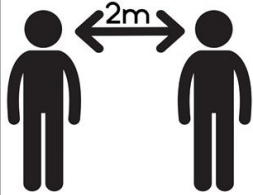
Please support the school, staff and the children by ensuring this is the case. Thank you.
