




A Wembrook Wedding

A Message from the Leisure Trust

During the Easter break (06/04-09/04 & 12/04 - 16/04) we have an opportunity to offer 15 free places on our new holiday provision Playscheme at Middlemarch School for children who are residents within Hilltop & Caldwell catchment area. Spaces have been funded by HTC Big Local so at the moment we can only offer out to residents, although we are hoping to open up paid spaces to the wider public at a later date.
