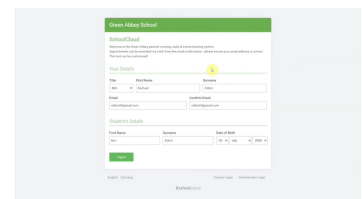
If you do not have access to the internet, please contact the school office who will be happy to add appointments on your behalf.
