## **Unprecedented Times!**

Continuing the theme from last week, I want all parents to be aware of the challenges we are facing on a daily basis. Things you might want to know:

- ⇒ So far we have not had one school day where all school staff have been able to attend work.
- ⇒ We are averaging around 25 PCR tests a day with suspected Covid.
- ⇒ The office have concluded that at least the first two hours of each morning is being taken up with Covid related issues.
- ⇒ We are averaging around 8 to 10 pupils being sent home daily, due to them not being well or displaying classic Covid symptoms.

Wembrook is clearly not alone. My weekly Headteacher Team meetings with the LA are making very gloomy viewing at the moment, as I hear about how other schools are also struggling with the challenges. This is why we all need to continue with doing what we are doing. It is the only way we are going to get through this.

Please remember

- If your child is self isolating, work will be sent to the pupil's school email.
- Please read all communications between school and home with care. Our telephones are very busy with many questions being asked, when the answers have already been given.
- You know your child best. If you are reporting that your child is ill with a symptom then we must ask for you to have them PCR tested. If you know that they have not got Covid then reflect on what you say.
- When leaving messages on either ParentMail or the answerphone, please be specific with type of illness and not report **unwell.** This will save the office ladies making multiple phonecalls for clarification.
- Have a serious chat with your child about fabricating illnesses. The frustrating reality is if your child says they have various symptoms, then we have to respond.
- If another child in your child's class is Covid positive then you will receive a letter requesting your child to have a PCR test. Please support the request.
- The Delta variant can show as a **headache and sickness**.
- LFT's have their place but should not be used if any symptoms are present no matter how minor. Just because the LFT says negative does not necessarily mean you are. A PCR is much more accurate and should be used if symptoms are present.
- If you have taken a PCR because you have symptoms, isolate until you have the results. If you have taken a test because you are just being cautious you may go about your business.
