
EASTER BINGO IS BACK!

How does it works?

Adult pays £1 to enter. Children are free. All get raffle tickets for the door prize. There are 5 main games for the night. A set of tickets start at just £3.00 and go up to £8.00 for a book of six.

A final additional flier is from £1.50.

All children's tickets are significantly less.

Refreshments and a raffle are also available.

It usually finishes shortly after 8:30pm.



Parents Evening

Tuesday 5th April 3:30pm to 6:00pm IN PERSON Wednesday 6th April 4:00pm to 6:30pm VIRTUAL

As we slowly return to a new normal, you are provided with a choice for this terms parents evening. One night will be in school (Tuesday), one night will be through Video calls (Wednesday).

In School (Tuesday 5th April)

Meetings to take place in pupils classrooms. You will enter via the classroom from the outside door (except Year Five). **No crèche, so no children to come to school**. Parents to wear masks, as will teachers. There will be an opportunity to see pupils books in the meeting. Each meeting will last 9 minutes. If you have more than one child you should move to the second class via the outside of the school building.

Virtually (Wednesday 6th April)

This is appropriate if you cannot get to school or do not have child care.

The opportunity will last 9 minutes. If you are late to the meeting you will not be able to gain entry. At the end of the allotted time the meeting will automatically finish.

Appointments can be made from today and will close on Friday 1st April at 3:00pm. Should you wish to make any changes after this date please contact the school office.

The system should recognise all your children who attend Wembrook.

If you do not have access to the internet, please contact the school office who will be happy to add appointments on your behalf.
