Parent and Pupil Questionnaires

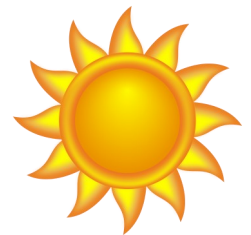
Congratulation to Alfie's Grandma in Year Four who won the All4One voucher.
