Parents Evening

Following on from last year as we slowly return to a new normal, you are provided with a choice for this terms parents evening. One night will be in school (Wednesday), one night will be through Video calls (Thursday).

In School (Wednesday 19th October)

Meetings to take place in pupils classrooms. You will enter via the classroom from the outside door (except Year Five). **No crèche, so <u>no children</u> to come to school**. There will be an opportunity to see pupils books in the meeting. Each meeting will last 9 minutes. If you have more than one child you should move to the second class via the outside of the school building.

Virtually (Thursday 20th October)

This is appropriate if you cannot get to school or do not have child care. The opportunity will last 9 minutes. If you are late to the meeting you will not be able to gain entry. At the end of the allotted time the meeting will automatically finish.

Appointments can be made from today and will close on Friday 14th October at 3:00pm. Should you wish to make any changes after this date please contact the school office.
