Important Information for all Parents, including Foundation and Key Stage One.

Although all pupils in Reception and Key Stage 1 are entitled to a free school meal there are **many advantages** for still applying for free school meals if you are on a low income. The advantages include, reduced costs for school trips and free access for certain school activities.

Is my child entitled to a Free School Meal?

If you receive the following you will be eligible for free school meals:

Income Support

Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance

Income-related Employment and Support Allowance

The guaranteed element of Pension Credit

Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)

Working Tax Credit run on

Universal Credit-if you applied after 1/4/18 and your income is less than £7,400

The school receives a significant amount of money for every application which we then use to resource the school. It is therefore very important that everybody who is entitled makes an application regardless of whether your child wishes to have dinners or sandwiches.

Parents and pupils entitled to free school meals no longer have to reapply but must inform the authority if there are any changes in their circumstances.
