After three years of disruption we are finally returning to the normal format with parents evening, there are just a few limited tweaks!

Both evenings will take place in person, where parents will not only have the opportunity to talk to the teacher but they will also be able to look at their child's work. The object of the meeting is to see how your child has made progress during the term and how you can support them throughout the rest of the year.

To ensure that timings are followed your allocated time will be for 10 minutes.

If parents need extra time they are welcome to arrange an additional meeting to continue the discussion.

Mr Pearson, Miss Bayliss and Mrs Chard will be available on both days. Mrs Jones, the Special Educational Needs Coordinator, will also be available.

Entrance to all meetings will be through the main reception area at the front of the school.
