Covid has not gone away!

Worryingly, the school is beginning to see a slight spike in Covid cases as we head towards the winter.

To ensure the safety and wellbeing of children, we all have a role to play. The LA/DFE guidelines are the same as last year.

- If your child is showing clear Covid symptoms please keep them off and monitor. A **temperature** can be a strong indicator along with the other symptoms.
- If possible please test them. If negative they may come to school.
- If positive, they can not come to school on that day (Day 0), they must then remain absent for another three days.
- If well and they do not have a temperature, they may return to school on Day Four.

We know that many children will have minor coughs and sneezes and clearly it can be difficult to know the difference. However, it would be wise to assume if anyone else in your house has already got Covid and others have symptoms, then it probably is Covid!

Clearly we do not want to place anyone, whether it is a child or a member of staff at an increased risk. We sincerely hope you will support the school with these actions.

All parents who choose to send their children to Wembrook must support the school uniform. This includes shoes that are black in colour. Please ensure this is the case.
